ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

- PNCC will award \$1,000 each to four qualified applicants (\$500 each per semester during the same academic year as the award)
- Three-month paid internship at PNCC immediately after graduation
- May be offered a 2-year paid contract after the internship program with full benefits.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- · Palauan citizen
- Second-year student at PCC
- Minimum GPA of 2.5
- Must have completed 32 or more credit hours
- Full-time student with 12 credits per semester
- Must complete their program in spring or summer of the same academic year as the scholarship

- 1. What is the purpose of the PNCC Scholarship?
 - Designed to help bridge the financial gap that often prevents students from finishing their dream of higher education.
 - Offered to second year PCC students
 - Gateway into workforce
- 2. What are the benefits of the PNCC Scholarship Program?
 - 4 recipients of the scholarship will each get:
 - \$1,000 cash for their last year
 - (\$500 per semester)
 - o 3 Months Paid Internship in the summer by PNCC
 - May be offered a 2-year contract with PNCC after internship
- 3. Who is eligible for the Scholarship?
 - ❖ PNCC Scholarship is for Palauan students enrolled in Palau Community College in their second and final year.
 - Students must have minimum 2.5 GPA
 - Must have complete 32 or more credit hours
 - Must be a full-time student with 12 credits per semester.
- 4. When can I apply?
 - Beginning of Fall Semester of each year.
- 5. When will the PNCC Scholarship be awarded to students?
 - Scholarships are awarded to students by the end of October of each year.

- 6. When is the deadline to turn in scholarship application?
 - ❖ All PNCC Scholarship applications should be submitted to Student Life or Development Office.
 - ❖ All APLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED BY THE END OF SEPTEMBER of each year
- 7. What degree programs are eligible for the Scholarship?
 - ❖ The Scholarship is offered to PCC students in:
 - o All School of Technical Education Programs
 - o Business Accounting,
 - Information Technology,
 - Office Administration, and
 - Tourism and Hospitality Programs.

 - o Copy of Birth Certificate or Passport or Certification of Palau Citizenship
 - Official PCC Transcript
 - Official Class Schedule from PCC Admissions and Records Office
 - o 1 recommendation letter from Instructor
 - Essay
 - 300 500 words, typewritten
 - "How will this scholarship meet my educational goals?"
 - 1 picture ID (passport size)

I. IMPORTANT INFORMATION

A. CRITERIA OF ELIGIBILITY

- a. Proof of Citizenship (Must be a Palauan Citizen)
- b. Enrolled as a full-time student at Palau Community College for Fall Semester with a minimum of 12 credit: a minimum cumulative grade point (GPA) of 2.50
- c. Must have acquired 32 or number of credits
- d. Must be majoring in any one of these programs
 - a. Air Conditioning and Refrigerator
 - b. Automotive Technology
 - c. Business Accounting
 - d. Construction Technology
 - e. Electrical Technology
 - f. Information Technology
 - g. Office Administration
 - h. Small Engine & Outboard Marine Technology
 - i. Tourism & Hospitality
- e. Must be in their last year of Degree Program
- f. Must list second year Course Name and Course Numbers
- g. Must include Palau Community College official transcript

The student must maintain a full-time status with at least 12 credit hours to remain eligible for the next semester.

(A Minimum Cumulative GPA of 2.50 must be maintained to remain in eligible; otherwise, the student may be liable to reimburse a portion of the entire amount of scholarship money.)
